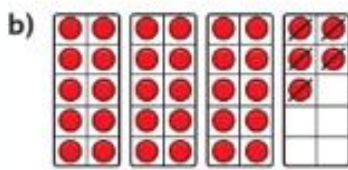
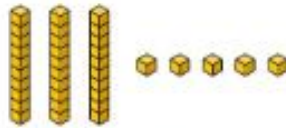
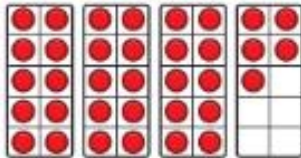


Video 1 Subtracting a 1 digit number from a 2 digit number

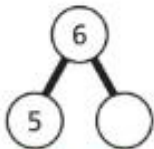

a) Children in Class 2.

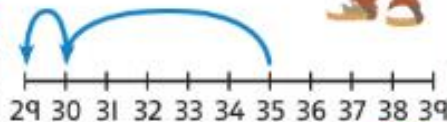


We can do the subtraction in two parts. We subtract 5 first.

$$35 - 5 = 30$$



I know that if the whole is 6 and one of the parts is 5, then the other part is 1. So I will subtract 1 more.



$$30 - 1 = 29$$

$$35 - 5 - 1 = 29$$

There are 29 children in Class 2 today.



$$35 - 6 =$$

To take away 6, I know that the whole is 6 and one part is 5 because my nearest 10 is 30

$$\text{So } 35 - 5 = 30$$

The other part is 1

$$\text{because } 6 = 5 + (1) \text{ or } 6 - 5 = 1$$

$$30 - 1 = 29$$
