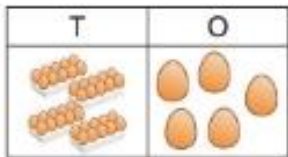


Video 3 Subtracting a 2 digit number from a 2 digit number

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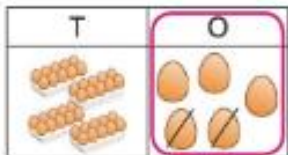
I will start with the greatest number.

a)

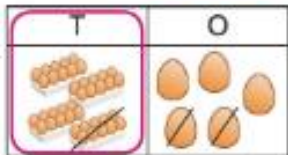


$$\begin{array}{r} \text{T O} \\ 45 \\ - 12 \\ \hline \end{array}$$

I could try crossing out 12 eggs: 1 and 2 .



$$\begin{array}{r} \text{T O} \\ 45 \\ - 12 \\ \hline 33 \end{array}$$

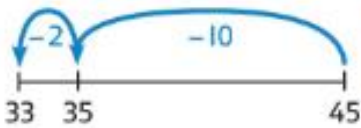
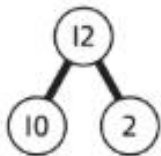


$$\begin{array}{r} \text{T O} \\ 45 \\ - 12 \\ \hline 33 \end{array}$$



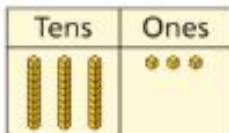
$$45 - 12 = 33$$

There are 33 eggs left.



I used a number line.

b)



$$\begin{array}{r} \text{T O} \\ 33 \\ - 20 \\ \hline 13 \end{array}$$

There are 13 eggs left.

Look at section A

$$45 - 12 =$$

Always start with the **ones**:

$$(5 - 2 = 3)$$

Then over to the **tens**

$$4 \text{ tens} - 1 \text{ ten} = 3 \text{ tens}$$

$$45 - 12 = 33$$
